**2. Declarations of Interest**

**5. Receive information on the following ongoing issues and decide further action where necessary**

**5.1 Drains/Flooding in Sessay** – Cllr Walburn reported after the recent rainfall there was no flooding in the village, but it was noted the Cricket field had standing water on it. It was noted there has been some work carried out by YW and possibly there has been some improvement to prevent the flooding.

**5.2 Response from NY Police re speed cameras in village** – The clerk advised Cllr Sladden is assisting with our request for the mobile speed camera to attend the village. Cllr Andrews advised she has been doing some researching and any village that has street lamp posts should be 30mph speed limit. It was resolved to contact NYC highways requesting a 30mph in Hutton Sessay if they say no then we require justification of a reason why not. The 40mph speed limit markings on the road have gone when the road was resurfaced. It was agreed to state we have increased pedestrians and children walking through the village.

**5.3** New dog waste/litter bins – the bins are installed.

**5.4** Re-filming/cleaning of road signs – Cllr Kelham has prepared a plan of the signs that require attention to pass on to NYC.

**5.5** Fibre optic broadband in Sessay – Cllr Walburn attended the online meeting recently held when we discovered that they have got fibre in the village the fibre cable goes to the school and although there are nodes at various places in the village. The cable was installed on some scheme so no-one else can benefit from it. Over the last two months a tender has been for an upgrade, the tender results will be announced in 6 weeks. won the tender will decide what Sessay is going to get. It might be a 5G system will be put in and 5G masts up there will be grant money available to be applied for.

## 6. NYC matters

**6.1 New Mills** – no acknowledgment has been received from NYC to our email, it was agreed to send again. Cllr Sladden will also try to find out the current situation for us.

**6.1.2 Road Widening** – The reinstatement of the road is in hand and will happen, but no date has been fixed when this might be.

Cllr Sladden report the results of the traffic speeds in Hutton Sessay average speeds were recorded at 26.9 mph, 85 percentile 35.6 peak time weekdays between 10am and 4pm. Cllr Kerman asked how this is captured. It was felt this information was not accurate, this could be due to the t junction people slowing down to pull out of that junction.

**ZB24/00809/FUL** siting of one cabin with external decking area Burtree House York Road Hutton Sessay Thirsk YO7 3AY – Council no objections to this application but it was agreed to ask what is the purpose of the permanent scaffolding on the road side.

**ZB24/00615/FUL** retrospective application for erection of two tents on a raised deck, garden folly, bar toilet and shown block Burtree House York Road Hutton Sessay YO7 3AY – Council had no objection.
